## **Significant Arrests**

1/03/09, Citizens flagged down Officers Higgins and Nyantakyi to report a robbery taking place around 3<sup>rd</sup> and Franklin. Officers responded to the area and observed the suspects but they jumped into a truck and fled before the Officers could make an apprehension. Officer Higgins put out a description of the vehicle and minutes later Detective Chris Foulz observed the vehicle wreck in the 700 block of N. 3<sup>rd</sup> where he apprehended Anthony Jones. One firearm was recovered from the truck and another was recovered after a citizen called to report that the suspects had thrown a gun out of the truck (which landed inside of a parked car). One suspect was able to get away so this investigation is on-going. Fortunately no one was hurt in this incident. This was great teamwork by the citizens who assisted and all of the Officers on patrol that night!!

1/06/09, Bike Officers William Travers and Dawn Lehmann were flagged down in the 200 block of N. 2<sup>nd</sup> by a citizen who stated that her car had been broken into and that her laptop had been stolen. The Officers immediately responded to the pawn shops in the area to see if anyone had been in with a laptop. No one had been in but the shops advised the Officers that they would call if anyone came in. While the Officers were investigating this incident – they were stopped by another citizen whose car had been broken into and a citizen who witnessed the incident. The witness was able to provide the license plate and a description of the suspect vehicle.

While gathering the info – Jefferson Loan called to advise the Officers that someone had just come in with a laptop. Officers responded immediately and observed the suspect vehicle outside. Jerome Porter was charged with destruction of private property and larceny from both cars. Investigation revealed that the vehicle - that the suspect was in - was also stolen and he was charged accordingly. Items recovered from the trunk of the car linked Mr. Porter to another larceny from Monroe Ward from the day prior so he was charged with a 4th larceny. This great arrest would not have happened without the quick assistance of the witness and Jefferson Loan and the continued determination of the Downtown Bike Officers!! Great work by all!!!

Detective Sergeant Allan Miles is following up on another stolen auto where numerous stolen items were recovered. Kevin Richardson has been arrested for the auto theft and Miles has been able to tie him to at least 5 thefts from cars – charges are pending. Detective Frank Misiano responded to a theft from a car in Monroe Ward in August and recovered DNA evidence that has linked Mr. Richardson to the crime. Detective Levin White has obtained warrants charging him with this one. Fantastic follow up from Sergeant Miles and the Detectives!!!



## *What's going on in your neighborhood?*

### **Oregon Hill**

Oregon Hill reported only 1 crime in January – this was the alleged rape from the crime alert that I sent on Jan. 19<sup>th</sup>. I cannot release any further details on the case at this time. It is still under investigation and details are still unclear.

### **Jackson Ward**

Violent Crime in Jackson Ward was down 50% in January. Property Crime, however; was up 50%. Burglary, shoplifting and thefts from cars were the biggest problems. Please remember not to leave anything in your cars and remember to lock your doors and close your blinds when you leave your home. I do believe that the arrests that we made at the end of the month will impact the thefts from cars – but there is always someone out there ready to take over. Please call us if you see anything suspicious and keep an eye out for your neighbors. The Neighborhood Assistance Officers have volunteered to assist us with getting out information on thefts from cars in your neighborhood but I know that it is nothing that you haven't seen already or heard on the phone from the Reverse 911s. We really need your assistance to prevent these crimes!!!

### **Monroe Ward**

It is not a surprise that Monroe Ward's biggest problem this month was thefts from cars – 11 cars broken into. We have increased patrols in that area but again – we need your help!! Do not leave anything in your cars – no matter how insignificant you think it may be – loose change, a coat CDs, etc.
